1. What are some of the reasons why one person might chose to love another?
2. What are some of the reasons that a Christian should have for loving another?

Read 1 Peter 1:22 – 2:3.

3. What does it mean to be born again? What does it mean to have a purified soul? Is there a difference between the two in the passage?
4. Where does a pure soul/heart come from? What do you need to plant to get one?
5. What does *earnest love* look like? Is *earnest love* any different to normal average *love*? How come Peter specifies?
6. What sorts of things are born of perishable seed? What sorts of things are born of imperishable seed?
7. What is 'the word' in verse 25? (uses verses 24 and 25 to come up with an complete answer!)
8. What's the connection between love and things that can never perish? How should this change the way we live?
9. According to the passage, is it natural to feel malice, deceit, envy, hypocrisy, envy and slander? Explain?
10. According to the passage, why should we put away malice, deceit, envy, hypocrisy, envy and slander? Do we get any tips on how?
11. Which of these do you find it hardest to put away? Why?
12. Why would you need to grow up into salvation? Are we not saved simply by trusting Jesus?
13. What should knowing God's goodness motivate you to do? How come?
14. What does tasting that the Lord is good have to do with all this?
