QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION OR REFLECTION

Passage: Matthew 15:21-39

Read Matthew 15:21-39.

- 1. What two things do we learn about this woman's racial/cultural background? How might a typical Jew view this woman?
- 2. What does this woman want Jesus to do? How do we feel about this woman and her request? How does Jesus respond to her?
- 3. What response does Jesus give the woman in v.24? What do you think this means?
- 4. Why do you think Jesus' is reluctant to make the woman an exception to the rule?
- 5. What can we learn about Jesus from his interactions with the woman so far? How does Jesus challenge our own views about himself?
- 6. What is shocking about Jesus' words in v.26? What does Jesus mean?
- 7. What is remarkable about the woman's response in v.27? How might this response encourage/challenge our faith and how we view ourselves?
- 8. What kind of area does Jesus travel to in v.29? In what ways do vv.29-31 contrast with vv.21-28?
- 9. What response do all these miracles elicit from Israel?
- 10. What are the similarities and differences between the feeding of the 4,000 (vv.32-39) and the feeding of the 5,000 (14:31-21)?
- 11. What might the differences teach us about the scope of Jesus' mission?
- 12. What do you think these feeding miracles are supposed to teach us? How can they encourage us in our trust of Jesus?
