Topic: Maturity (Colossians 1)

Read Colossians 1:9-12.

1. What do you think is 'the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding' (v.9)?
2. What do you think it means to be filled with it?
3. What is the direct result of being filled with it (v.10)?
4. Having said that the knowledge of God's will results in a life worthy of God and pleasing to him, Paul then gives four marks of this new way of living in vv.10-12. What are they?
5. What is the fruit that we should bear (v.10)?
6. What kind of knowledge are mature Christians growing in (v.10)?
7. What does it mean 'to be strengthened with all power' (v.11)?
8. Why does Paul call Christians 'the saints in Light' (v.12)? What is their inheritance?
9. To what degree do you feel your life is focused on being filled with the knowledge of God's will?
10. Do you see these four marks of maturity in your own life?

Read Ephesians 4:11-16.

11. According to this passage, what is the importance of the church in Christian maturity?
12. What role does the church play in maturing Christians?
13. What is the goal of Christian maturity for the church?
14. What would you say to someone who feels church isn't that important?
