3. Why have you included the events you've included? What is significant about them?

4. Though we don't need to rank these events... Make your case in the group for which you think is the most significant moment. Argue about the order..

5. Why does God hear the cries of his people? Why does he care?

6. What do you think it meant that 'God knew' (ESV)?

Read Exodus 3:6-17

7. What does God do when God cares?

8. Why does God introduce himself to Moses and to Israel?

Exodus 1-18

9. Who are main characters in the book of Exodus? (Not all should be individual human beings!!)

10. What should we have learned about God so far in Exodus?

11. What should we have learned about People so far in Exodus?

12. What should we have learned about God plan of salvation for the world so far in Exodus? (Think generally and Passover specifically)
