QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION OR REFLECTION –  
Exodus 11-12

Read Exodus 11:1-10

1. What has Pharaoh learned about God since asking ‘Who is the Lord?’ (Exodus 5:2)?
2. Think back over the preceding chapters – what has God demonstrated that he has authority over? What does this reveal about God?
3. Why is God so specific about the time, content, scope and outcome of the plague? In the light of what God has demonstrated of himself to Pharaoh, how adequate is your understanding of God? Is there anything in your life you secretly think is too big for him to deal with?
4. Why do you think Moses ‘went out from Pharaoh in hot anger’? V8

Read Exodus 12:1 - 20

5. Why were the people to paint blood over the top of the door and on the door posts? (v7)
6. Why was the manner of their eating important – v11? What were they to be ready for?

Read Exodus 12:21-42

7. Why is this event so important? Why do you think it was to be taught to each generation? What things do we teach each generation?
8. Why is it important that God has compelled the most powerful man and nation in the world, against their will – to release his people v41-42?

The Passover and You

9. Why do you think all the gospels link Jesus’ death so closely with the Passover? (Mt 26:17; Mk 14:12 Lk 22:7-8)?
10. If Jesus is our Passover sacrifice (1 Corinthians 5:7) – what great power(s) has Jesus delivered us from? What evil have you been liberated from? In what ways are you tempted to still dabble with things you have been delivered from?
