QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION OR REFLECTION –  
Exodus 3-4

Read Exodus 3:1-10

1. Why is it that Moses can't come any closer? Why is it 'holy ground'?  
What does holy mean and why is it applied to God more than any other description in Scripture?
2. Why has God 'come down' to his people in v7-8 (see also 2:24-25)?  
What does this reveal about God?
3. What is the big change in v10 compared with v6-9? Do you think that God uses you in achieving his plans? Why or why not?

Read Exodus 3:11 - 22

4. In v11-12, what is Moses wrongly focusing on? How does God correct him?
5. What is the personal name of God that is made known to Moses in v15? Wherever you see 'LORD' (ie in capitals) written in the OT, that is the translation of God's name. If you see 'Lord' (ie lower case) it is some form of honorific rather than God's personal name.

Read Exodus 4:1-9

6. Who is Moses worried about convincing? Does this surprise you?

Read Exodus 4:10-17

7. Why is Moses worried about being 'slow of speech and tongue'? How does God assure Moses? How do you typically feel when you are speaking God's words to others? Do you believe God is greater than your inadequacies?
8. God promises Moses 'I will be with you) (Ex 3:12, 4:12). It is his reassurance for his service. For Christians, God is not only with us (Heb 13:5) but *In* us! How does this encourage us to persevere in service?
