QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION AND DISCUSSION
PSALMS 1 & 2

Read Psalm 1

1. How does Psalm 1 make God's way attractive?
2. What makes someone wicked?
3. What is 'the law of the LORD' referring to in verse 2?
4. How can you meditate on the LORD's law? Share as a group some ways you have found helpful?
5. What do you think "delighting in the LORD's law" means? Has this been your experience?
6. How can you help each other delight and meditate in the LORD's law?
7. What makes it hard to do verse 2?
8. Do you think verse 3 is a realistic picture of being a Christian? Why/why not?

Read Psalm 2:

1. Does anything surprise you about God's behaviour in this Psalm?
2. What do the rebels mean when they speak in verse 3? What is their understanding of God?
3. Who is the king verse 6 is speaking of? When did verse 6 happen?
4. Some of verses 7-9 have already happened and some are still to come. Read and discuss how the following passages use these verses:
 - Luke 3:22, Acts 4:23-30, Matthew 28:18, Acts 13:32-34, Romans 1:4 and Revelation 19:11-16.
5. Finally, discuss how kissing the Son (verse 12) is an ongoing behaviour for Christians. What are the day-to-day practicalities of this?
