QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION OR REFLECTION
Right and Wrong in a Modern World – Part 2

1. Is it fair to describe Christian's as people who are always trying to obey the rules?
2. What's good about living in a country with a law?
3. *Read Exodus 20:1-21.* Who does the passage tell us these laws written for? Who do you think these laws applicable for? How come?
4. Do all of these laws make sense to you? Do they seem to reflect your understanding of right and wrong?
5. *Skim Exodus 20-23.* What are the ten commandments an introduction to? Why would God have set the law out this way?
6. *Read Proverbs 8:12-36.* As Wisdom speaks to us in the Psalm what do we learn about right, wrong and creation? How does God's wisdom leave its imprint on the creation?
7. *Read Philippians 4:2-9.* Are there any rules in this passage? How do you define rules?
8. What should our response be if we read a law in the bible that doesn't ring true for us?
9. Can you think of a law or rule in the bible that you have struggled to understand or come to terms with?
10. If we are saved through forgiveness is it important that we try and keep Gods laws and commands? Why/Why not?
11. *Read Psalm 119:1-8* (More if you've got time!). How will God bless us if we keep his commands?
