QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION OR REFLECTION  
Talking about Jesus with Roman Catholics

1. Think of the Roman Catholics that you know. How confident do they seem about their eternal destination? Why do you think this is?
2. How would you respond to the person who says ‘we shouldn’t sheep steal from Roman Catholics’? Why do we want to talk with Roman Catholics about Jesus? What is our goal?
3. What is God’s grace? What does it mean to you that God is gracious to you in the Lord Jesus Christ?
4. The Protestant Reformation is the historical period where Christians protested (hence ‘protest-ant’) against the teachings of institutional Roman Catholicism. During this controversy – the five ‘alones’ or ‘solas’ (Latin for alone) emerged as key points of contention. Pick ONE of the following protestant points. What does it mean? How is this different to Roman Catholicism? Does it matter?
  - Scripture alone
  - Christ alone
  - Grace alone
  - Faith alone
  - To the Glory of God alone
5. Think of the Roman Catholics you know. How could you encourage them to come to have certainty for eternity? Are there any steps you need to take? Pray about these together.
6. Do you think we should be engaging Roman Catholics we know with the gospel of Jesus? Why / Why not? How has this sermon helped you to do this? What will you do in response?
