QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION OR REFLECTION
Incarnation ~ Knowing God

1. Where in the opening to John's gospel (John 1:1-18) does John make it clear that the 'Word' is simultaneously God's own peer and God's own self?
2. What is the Word's relationship to broader creation? How is it dependent upon the Word?
3. What does 'incarnation' mean?
4. Why is good news that 'the word became flesh'? v14. How does this give us confidence in our speaking about God?
5. We cannot look directly on God, according to John 1:18. What is, at present, the closest we can come? How will this affect your reading of the gospels – Matthew, Mark, Luke and John?
6. What are you most grateful for today regarding the revealed character and work of Jesus Christ in this passage? Offer praise to God in response.
7. God becoming a human being shows his determination that we might know him. Does that strengthen your desire to talk with others about Jesus? Why / Why not?
8. This Christmas, what would help you remember and celebrate that God has made himself known?
