Passage: Luke 24:1-35

SHARE: What different opinions do Australians have about the resurrection of Jesus?

1. If there is a God, are there any reasons to think that the resurrection of Jesus is incredible?

Read Luke 24:1-12

2. What expectations did these women appear to have as they approached the tomb?
3. Why are the angels surprised by these expectations?
4. Why do you think the apostles considered the women's report untrue?

Read Luke 24:13-35

5. How do these disciples describe Jesus to himself? What is missing from their description?
6. What hope did these disciples have for Jesus prior to his crucifixion? How do you think they understood this hope?
7. What is Jesus' rebuke of them? Why should they have understood the truth?
8. What do we learn from this account about the nature of Jesus' resurrection body?

Read Romans 3:23-24; 1 Cor. 1:30; Eph. 1:7

9. What did Jesus come to redeem his people from?
10. What evidences do you see in this passage for the resurrection of Jesus?
11. What does the resurrection of Jesus tell us about Jesus? What does it mean for our lives?
