**QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION OR REFLECTION**  
Passage: Luke 24:36-49

1. Who has seen the resurrected Jesus so far in the story? Who has not yet?

**Read Luke 24:36-43**

2. Who is present as Jesus appears out of nowhere and says: "Peace to you"?
3. What conclusion do the disciples draw from this about Jesus? Why do you think they concluded he was a ghost rather than a resurrected Jesus?
4. What evidence does Jesus present to prove that he really is the resurrected Jesus?

**Read Luke 24:44-49**

5. Jesus has repeated so many times that he would die and rise again from the dead, and that this is what the Law and prophets teach. Why do you think the disciples continually fail to get it?
6. What must Jesus do for them to be able to understand (v.45)? What does this tell us about how we can rightly understand Scripture?
7. What do we learn from vv.46-47 about why Jesus was resurrected and what stage of salvation is about to commence? What does this tell us about how we should be living now?
8. In vv.48-49, Jesus promises that the disciples will be clothed by the power of God on high. What is he referring to here? What difference does it make to know we have the very power of God working in us?

**Read John 16:7-11 and 1 Cor. 12:3.**

9. What is the role of the Holy Spirit in the proclamation of the gospel? Why might this be a comforting thought when we are afraid or unsure what to say?
10. Christians are called to be missionaries wherever they are. Why might it look like to be a missionary where we are? Do we find it easy to pray regularly for opportunities to speak about Jesus?

Think of 2-3 people in your life and pray for specific opportunities to speak to them about Jesus
