QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION OR REFLECTION

Passage: Revelation 21:9 – 22:21

What are you most looking forward to in the new creation?

Read Revelation 21:1-22:5

1. What does it mean that the bride, the wife of the lamb is a city?
2. What is being emphasized in the list of the dimensions of the city? What is the significance of the gates and foundations (v12-14)?
3. Why is there no temple in the city? What else is excluded from the city?
4. How does John describe our relationship with God in the new creation?

Read Revelation 22:6-21

5. What is John's mistake in v8-9?
6. What blessings are promised to God's people?
7. What warnings are given? How can you ensure you avoid errors he mentions?
8. What will Jesus do when he returns (v12)? Does this excite you or scare you?
9. Jesus promises 3 times (v7, 12, 20) that he is coming soon. What does He mean by 'soon'? What should we be doing now to prepare for His return?

Summary

10. How earnestly do we pray "Come Lord Jesus"? How much do we desire his return, and the salvation of others for his glory?
11. Will heaven be very different from earth, or just a bit better? Why?
12. Think back over your study of Revelation. What are you thankful for? What difference has it made to your confidence in God? What difference does it make to your life now?
