### QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION OR REFLECTION

Bible Passage: Titus 3

Describe a recent example of someone being kind to you. How did it make you feel?

#### **Read Titus 3.**

- 1) What is Titus to
  - a) remind his church about (v1-2)?
  - b) stress to his church (v8)?
  - c) teach his church to avoid (v9)?
- 2) What is the uncomfortable truth Paul teaches us about ourselves in v3? Why did God save us?
- 3) What is the Holy Spirit's role in saving us (v5-6)?
- 4) What does this teach us about the kindness and love of God?
- 5) 'Good works' is an application that Paul repeats (see v1, 8, 14). What is the purpose of good works? How might 'learning' to be devoted to good works help us as we strive for godliness?
- 6) What are some concrete ways that we can do good to our brothers and sisters in Christ?
- 7) What are some concrete ways that we can do good in our community?
- 8) In v10-11 Paul uses very firm language to describe how elders must deal with people who stir up division. Why are such people so dangerous? What impact do they have on the church and God's purposes for it?
- 9) Why do we often find ourselves focusing on disagreements and quarrels, rather than the gospel? What can we do to combat that?
- 10) From the whole letter, how would you summarise what Paul has said about the gospel, godliness and teachers? How do these three themes work together?
- 11) What is one difference you'd like to make in your life from reading Titus? Pray about that with your group now.
